

Traffic Alert – Lane reductions on Broadway and Cambie starting June 10

June 10, 2022

- Starting June 10 through summer 2022, W. Broadway between Cambie and Ash Streets will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction on weekends and at night from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., and on weekdays during the day there will be one lane eastbound and two lanes westbound.
- Starting June 13 for approximately two weeks, Cambie Street between W. Broadway and W. 12th Avenue will be reduced to three lanes (2 southbound and 1 northbound) from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday-Friday. Traffic will return to two lanes northbound and two lanes southbound by 5 a.m. each day.
- The temporary closure supports the relocation of sewer lines beneath Cambie Street prior to building the new station at Broadway-City Hall.
- Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
