





Night Work to relocate utilities at Broadway and Cypress streets begins June 6



The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is relocating utilities at Cypress St. and W. Broadway to support major construction. Due to the location of the utilities (marked in orange in the map below), this work is being done overnight to minimize impacts to businesses, pedestrians, and traffic. No water interruptions are anticipated. If that changes, BSCGP will directly contact property owners and businesses we anticipate would be affected. Work is expected to take about two weeks to complete.

What to Expect

Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained. People in the area can expect temporary lane restrictions on Cypress St. and on W. Broadway, as well as temporary sidewalk detours around the work. The work will result in elevated noise during the night. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the early evening and minimizing the use of back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment during nighttime construction. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
