

## UPDATE: Utility relocation along East 1st Avenue and Carolina Street – night work

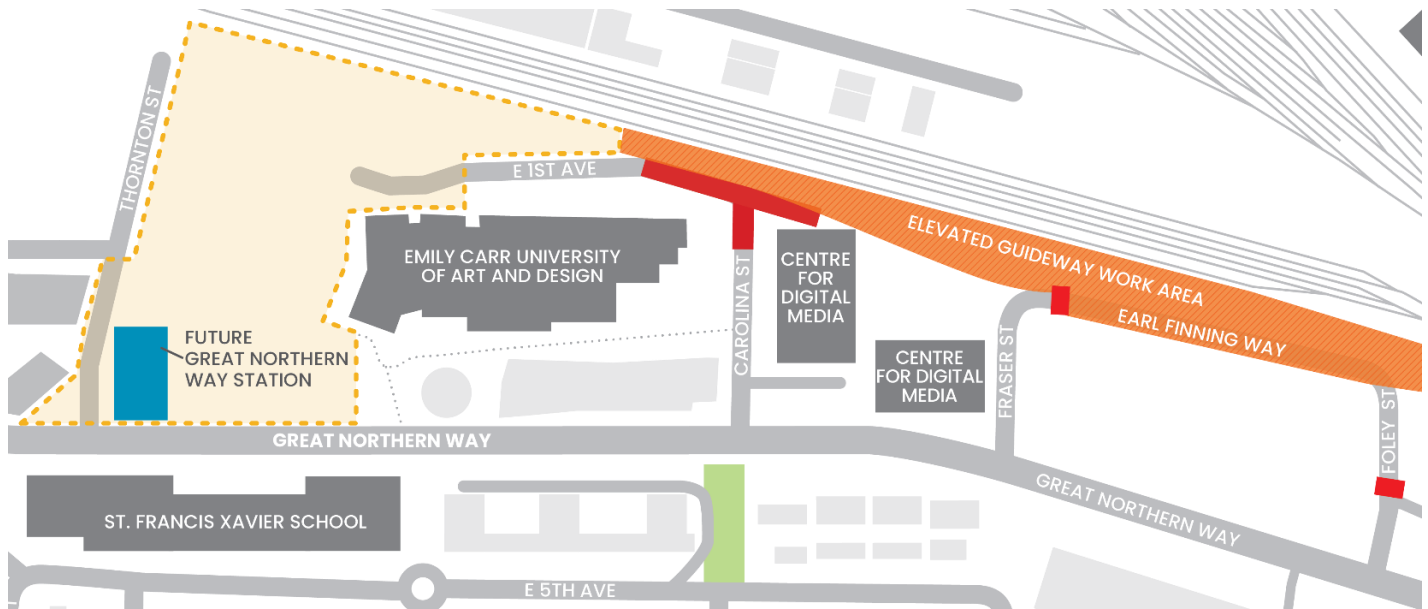
June 2, 2022

**Note: This is an update of the notification from April 14, 2022 and we now have revised times for the work timeline.**

From June 2 to June 6, 2022, crews will be finalizing the relocation and tie in of utilities along East 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Carolina Street between Emily Carr University of Art and Design and the Centre for Digital Media. Restricted access is shown in red on the map. Some night work may be required to complete this final part of the utilities relocation.

Vehicle access to East 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue from Carolina Street remains restricted and drivers are invited to use Fraser Street to enter the parkade area. Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required. Please watch for wayfinding information and follow instructions from traffic control personnel and all signs. Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots in the area will be maintained.
