





Update: Traffic patterns changing on W. Broadway between Cypress and Arbutus continues – includes night work


Note: The notice from July 21, 2022 includes this work and we have updated scheduling and traffic details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood installing the traffic deck on the south side of W. Broadway between Cypress and Arbutus streets. Work began July 9 and continues until July 27. BSPC will then begin building the traffic deck on the north side of W. Broadway. Vehicle access to Maple St. south is anticipated to reopen a few weeks following completion of the south side deck, while vehicle access to Maple St. north of W. Broadway will be restricted for the duration of the project. The full traffic deck is expected to be completed in the Fall of 2022.

What to Expect

Night work in preparation for the traffic shift and related works will be performed overnight to minimize impacts on businesses and residents. Work includes reconfiguring traffic signals and street lighting; road work; line removal and painting; and placement of barriers and sidewalk modifications. In preparation for and during the traffic shift intersections from Arbutus St. to Cypress St. will be managed by Traffic Control Personnel. The sidewalk on the north side of W. Broadway between Arbutus St to the east of the future Arbutus Station will be restricted for the duration of the Project. Once completed, the traffic deck will maintain an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic configuration while station construction continues below W. Broadway.

During this work, access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. People in the area can expect increased noise, congestion, reduced speed, and overnight turn restrictions on W. Broadway. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Noise mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and minimizing the use of back-up beepers. We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience.
