

# Traffic temporarily reduced to one lane in each direction on W. Broadway between Cambie and Ash streets starting August 17

August 16, 2022

**Note: The notice from [June 10, 2022](#) mentioned this work and we now have an updated schedule to share.**

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood relocating the sewer lines running beneath Cambie Street near the new Broadway-City Hall station. The sewer relocation activities include night work (8 p.m. – 5 a.m.) as well as regular day shifts until the end of summer 2022.

BSPC is beginning to excavate in the lanes on the west side of Cambie at the W. Broadway intersection. Crews will work overnight starting at 8 p.m. on August 17 until 5 a.m. on August 18 to set up for the traffic conditions that will be in place during excavation through early September. During the work, east-west traffic moving north through the intersection at Cambie at W. Broadway towards Ash Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Crosswalks and sidewalk segments may be restricted, and pedestrians will be detoured around work zones. Residents will experience elevated noise. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up beepers on construction equipment where possible, and performing the noisiest activities before 8 p.m. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
