

Night work at Arbutus St. and W. Broadway on September 8

September 6, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the traffic deck and will be reconfiguring streetlights and traffic signals at Arbutus St. and W. Broadway on September 8, 2022, from 7 pm through the night.

What to Expect

This work is being done at night to minimize impacts to traffic. Work includes reconfiguring traffic signals and street lighting, removing poles, and changing traffic signage. During the work the traffic signals at Arbutus St. and W. Broadway will be turned off and traffic will be managed by traffic control personnel. There will be temporary single lane alternating traffic on Arbutus St. between W. Broadway and W. 8th Ave. during the work. The work area is shown in orange on the map below, with red indicating current street closures.

During this work, access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. People in the area can expect to hear some noise and intermittent elevated noises, be detoured around the work, and experience congestion, reduced speed, and temporary lane restrictions. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Noise mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the early evening and minimizing the use of back-up beepers. We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience.
