





Utility location confirmation at Maple St. and W. 8th Ave. to take place on September 7 – Elevated noise

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood confirming underground utility locations at Maple St. and W. 8th Ave on Wednesday, September 7, 2022, from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.

What to Expect

Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained throughout the work. People in the area can expect elevated noise levels during hydrovac work to locate utilities. There will also be lane restrictions on Maple St. between W. 8th Ave. to the laneway towards W. Broadway. There will be single lane alternating traffic while work takes place in this intersection. Traffic will be controlled by traffic control personnel. The work area is shown in orange in the map below.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting this noisy activity during the day and minimizing the use of back-up beepers. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience.
