





Update: Traffic deck installation at the future Oak-VGH Station continues through October – Night Work

September 14, 2022

Note: The notice from August 5, 2022 includes this work and we have updated scheduling, traffic details, and impacts to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood finishing the traffic deck on the south side of W. Broadway in the Oak-VGH station block. Some work will be done overnight to minimize impacts to businesses and traffic including access to residences. The work, which began in August and will continue through October, includes road preparation, welding, followed by the installation of supports and deck panels on W. Broadway between Laurel and Oak streets. The traffic deck is expected to be completed in October.

What to Expect

Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained throughout. The work will result in elevated noise. People in the area can expect congestion, sidewalk modifications, overnight lane and turn restrictions on W. Broadway. Pedestrians may be detoured around the work. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and early evening, and minimizing the use of back-up beepers. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Laurel St. remains accessible to emergency vehicles only.
