





Night Work on W. Broadway between Granville and Hemlock Streets on September 18

September 15, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future South Granville Station. Work to widen the sidewalk on the south side of W. Broadway will take place between Granville and Hemlock Streets on September 18 beginning at 8 p.m.

What to Expect

This work is being done at night work to minimize impacts to businesses, commuters, and traffic. Work includes widening sidewalks, moving barriers, painting, and other related works. During the work, one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on W. Broadway. The work area is shown in orange in the map below.

Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. People in the area can expect to hear intermittent elevated noises, be detoured around the work, and experience congestion, reduced speed, and temporary lane closures. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. We thank residents for their patience while we conduct the necessary work.
