

Beginning October 11, the southbound lane on Arbutus St. from W. Broadway to W. 8th Ave. will be restricted to support utility relocation

Note: The notice from [March 14, 2022](#) includes this work and we have updated scheduling to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is relocating a watermain in your neighbourhood ahead of building the Arbutus Station. Beginning October 11, work to relocate the watermain will take place on Arbutus St. and requires the closure of the southbound lane from W. Broadway to W. 8th Ave. for up to two weeks. The work area is shown in orange below, with red indicating current street closures.

What to Expect

Work will be performed during the day. During this work, all southbound vehicle access will be restricted on Arbutus St. from W. Broadway to W. 8th Ave. Northbound vehicle access will be maintained. Vehicles travelling southbound are advised to take Cypress, Burrard, Yew, or Vine streets as alternate routes. Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, schools, and services.

People in the area can expect elevated noise levels, some traffic congestion, reduced speeds, and to be detoured around the work. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience.
