



CCTV surveys of utilities are happening near the future Broadway Subway Project Stations, October 2022 through January 2023 – Night Work

October 19, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be in neighbourhoods adjacent to Project activities to document and monitor the condition of utilities near all six of the future station locations. Closed-circuit TV cameras will be lowered into the lines through manhole openings in the roadway to record utility conditions.

To minimize traffic disruptions, the work will be performed overnight along Broadway, and across the alignment near the future station locations at Great Northern Way-Emily Carr, Mount Pleasant, Broadway – City Hall, Oak-VGH, South Granville, and Arbutus. Work will begin near Great Northern Way, move toward Mount Pleasant in October and westward towards other stations along the alignment through January 2023.

What to Expect

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

Work will be performed overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. and noise levels may periodically increase.

People in the area can expect temporary single-lane closures of up to one hour at monitoring locations, reduced speeds, and to be detoured around the work as required. Traffic control personnel will be present, as required, to assist with the safe movement of traffic, cyclists, and pedestrians. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience.
