

Traffic Alert – Lane closures and traffic pattern shift on W. Broadway from Spruce to Willow Streets beginning October 21

October 20, 2022

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Spruce and Willow streets from 8 p.m. on October 21 to 6 a.m. on October 22.
- A dedicated left-turn lane will be established on W. Broadway eastbound at Oak Steet.
- The addition of this lane will complete the traffic deck at the future Oak-VGH station.
- The traffic signals at W. Broadway and Oak Street and W. Broadway and Laurel Street will be controlled by traffic control personnel and/or VPD until work is complete.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained.
