

Traffic Alert – Main Street reduced to two lanes southbound at E. Broadway on October 15

October 14, 2022

- Main Street will be reduced to two lanes southbound for half a block between E. Broadway and E. 10th Avenue from 5 a.m. to as late as 8 p.m. on October 15.
- The lane closure supports the pouring of the future Mount Pleasant Station's foundation.
- Motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists will see concrete trucks travelling along Main Street (northbound and southbound), E. 10th Avenue (eastbound and westbound), and Quebec Street (northbound between E. 10th Avenue and E. Broadway).
- The sidewalk on the west side of Main Street in front of the construction site will be closed from E. Broadway to mid-block and pedestrians detoured to the east sidewalk.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access to area businesses will be maintained throughout the work.
- Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs, and plan extra travel time.
