

Next phase of construction activities begins with excavation under the traffic deck and pedestrian bridge installation – Some Night Work in November

November 3, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood working on the future station on W. Broadway between Oak and Laurel Streets. Construction activities in November include excavation and other work below the traffic deck while traffic moves above. Later in the month, a pedestrian bridge will be installed to reconnect pedestrian access on the south side of W. Broadway between Oak and Laurel streets. (Shown in green on the map below). Excavation activities below the traffic deck and in the future station building area will continue until spring 2023.

Hours of Work

Station and excavation preparation activities include day work from as early as 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. and periodic night work from 10:00 p.m. to 5 a.m. until the end of November 2022. Additional notification will be given in advance of specific activities performed at night once the schedule is confirmed.

What to Expect

Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services throughout the work. Work includes welding, drilling, excavating, and concrete placement, utility, and road work. The noisiest work will be carried out during the day. People in the area can expect elevated noise levels, some traffic congestion, reduced speeds, and to be detoured around the work. Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate as required. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience.
