- This one-way route will be in place until the end of the project.
- The Burrard Street access to the parking lots at 2401 W. Broadway, 1825 W. 8th Avenue, and 1850 W. 8th Avenue will be maintained.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained.
- Traffic will be controlled by traffic control personnel where necessary.
- Parking will be maintained on both sides of the road and will be east facing only.
- Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, new traffic signs and obey traffic control personnel.
