

Traffic deck installation at the future Arbutus station continues in December – Some Night Work

December 1, 2022

Note: The notice from [April 12, 2022](#) includes this work and we have updated scheduling and traffic details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building a traffic deck on W. Broadway between Cypress and Arbutus streets. Work on the south side of W. Broadway was completed in the summer. Preparatory work is nearly complete and installation will begin on the north side of W. Broadway in early December and continue through February 2023. The traffic deck will be completed in February 2023.

Residents and businesses will experience elevated noise and vibration during the installation and bolting of the traffic deck. People in the area should expect to see an increase of construction vehicles, temporary lane shifts and closures, and reduced speed limits and travel lanes. We also anticipate sidewalk and crosswalk modifications to accommodate some phases of work. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Timing

- December 2022 through February 2023



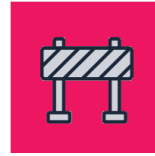
Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday
 - Day: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
 - Overnight: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- May include occasional work on Sunday.



Traffic

- In off-peak times, traffic on W. Broadway will be maintained to current daytime configuration.
- Single, alternating lanes between Cypress and Arbutus streets, from 10:00 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- 10-minute full road closures for crane movements, expected once an hour starting at 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 am
- Vehicle access to the north side of Maple St. from W. Broadway will be restricted until project completion.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Elevated noise and vibration.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.
