





Traffic Alert – Lane reductions on Main Street and Quebec Street on December 3

December 02, 2022

- Main Street will be reduced to two lanes southbound between E. Broadway and E. 10th Avenue from 4 a.m. to 10 p.m. on December 3.
- Parking restrictions along Quebec Street will be in place between E. 10th Avenue and the laneway towards E. Broadway as well as the eastbound curb lane of E. 10th Avenue between Quebec Street and the laneway.
- These lane restrictions support staging and movement of concrete trucks for constructing the future Mount Pleasant Station.
- Concrete trucks will travel along Main Street, E. 10th Avenue, and Quebec Street.
- Concrete trucks will be required to maintain engines running at all times to keep their drums turning.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access to area businesses will be maintained throughout the work.
- Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs, and plan extra travel time.
