

Night work for piezometer, geotechnical, and CCTV inspections near future station locations to the end of 2023

February 2, 2023

Following geotechnical investigations across the alignment of the future Millennium Line extension, the Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is returning to key locations to read geotechnical monitoring devices and piezometers (for water levels), as well as inspect utilities using closed-circuit TV (CCTV). The various readings will be taken over two nights, on a biweekly basis, until the end of 2023. This work could take up to two days and is not expected to be noisy. To minimize traffic disruptions, the work will occur overnight from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. and noise levels may periodically increase.

Work will begin near Great Northern Way, move toward Mount Pleasant and westward towards other stations along the alignment through to the end of 2023.

What to Expect

People in the area can expect temporary single-lane closures of up to one hour for CCTV monitoring locations with reduced speeds and detours around the work as required. There will be short-term traffic lane shifts (about 15 minutes in duration) at the test locations. A traffic truck with direction lights will indicate the lane shift, while crews take readings. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
