





Night work to implement traffic changes at Broadway-City Hall starting at 8 p.m. February 11

February 10, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood to implement the next stage of traffic changes at the future Broadway-City Hall station. The traffic shift signals completion of the traffic deck and establishes the longer-term traffic configuration, which includes restoring left-turn lanes on W. Broadway at Cambie. Work will include line painting, relocating traffic barriers, and signal work.

Timing

February 11 starting at 8 p.m. through 6 a.m. the following morning.

What to expect

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Yukon and Ash streets.
- Cambie Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction between W. 8th and W. 10th avenues.
- Vancouver Police will be directing motorists and pedestrians at the intersection of W. Broadway and Cambie Street while traffic signals are repositioned.
- The eastbound 99 B-Line bus stop in the 500-block of W. Broadway will be temporarily relocated to the west side of Ash Street during the work.
- Pedestrians may be detoured around work zones.
- Some elevated noise.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on construction equipment. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Benefits

- The #99 B-Line eastbound bus stop will be moved to in front of the Broadway-City Hall Canada Line Station beginning Monday, Feb. 13.
- A dedicated left-turn lane and signal will be added for vehicles turning from Broadway onto Cambie Street in each direction. Left turns from Cambie onto Broadway will remain restricted.
