





Traffic Alert – Overnight lane closures on W. Broadway and Cambie Street starting at 8 p.m. February 11

February 10, 2023

- Traffic on W. Broadway between Yukon and Ash streets will be reduced to one lane in each direction starting at 8 p.m. February 11 until 6 a.m. the following morning.
- Traffic on Cambie between W. 8th and W. 10th avenues will also be reduced to one lane in each direction for the same time period.
- Vancouver Police will direct motorists and pedestrians at the intersection of W. Broadway and Cambie Street while traffic signals are repositioned.
- The eastbound 99 B-Line bus stop in the 500-block of W. Broadway will be temporarily relocated to the west side of Ash Street during this work. Beginning Monday, Feb. 13, the B-Line bus stop will be relocated in front of the Broadway-City Hall Canada Line entrance.
- New dedicated left-turn lanes will be created on W. Broadway during the work, allowing for left turns onto Cambie Street.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained throughout this work.
- Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs, and plan extra travel time.
