

Next phase of construction begins at Oak-VGH Station

March 1, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. Beginning in March, excavation will continue and, in parallel, new work activities will begin focused on completing the underground station foundation and preparing for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines in the summer. Some activities may be conducted at night. Construction of the station will continue into 2024. See Page 2 for more detailed information.

Work hours

Typical hours of work are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays between the hours of 9 a.m. and 8 p.m. We will continue to keep you informed of work in advance to help you plan accordingly.

What to expect

- Elevated noise
- Increased trucking activity
- Temporary traffic changes
- Overnight lighting

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, installing noise barriers around sources of noise, conducting the noisiest activities during the day, directing lights away from residential buildings, utilizing quieter equipment where possible, and monitoring activities to adapt mitigations to changes.

- This phase of work will continue until the end of summer



Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m.
- There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays between the hours of 9 a.m. and 8 p.m.
- There may be occasional night work
- Please note the Project also has the ability to work 24/7



Traffic

- Temporary traffic restrictions, sidewalk modifications, pedestrian detours, and lower speed limits



Impacts/Interruptions

- Elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to crane movement, deliveries, rebar installation, and concrete activities
- Increased trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day or night
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety
