





Utility works at future OAK-VGH Station overnight on March 27

March 24, 2023

Note: The notice from March 1, 2023 includes night work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH station. As part of the excavation work, we will install a manhole on the north side of W. Broadway between Laurel and Oak streets as part of utility activities. Excavation works are expected to be completed in Spring 2023.

Timing

Utility work will begin at 8 p.m. on March 27 and continue overnight until 4 a.m. the following morning.

What to expect

- Overnight work
- Elevated noise related to the installation of the manhole and reinstatement of asphalt
- Temporary traffic changes will extend beyond the work area on W. Broadway between Spruce and Laurel streets

Mitigation measures include but are not limited to installing white noise back-up signals on some equipment, monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings.
