

Increased truck volumes around the Broadway-City Hall site on March 25

March 23, 2023

Note: The notice from [January 11, 2023](#) includes this work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Broadway-City Hall Station. Work on March 25 involves the second major pouring of the concrete base slab foundation in the 300-block of W. Broadway. The base slab will provide solid platforms for the tunnel boring machines to cross the station area and form the foundation for each station. In total, 140 trucks will pour 1,400 cubic meters of concrete over the course of the day. Trucks will use the following streets to access three concrete pouring locations:

- Cambie Street between W. 2nd and W. 12th avenues
- Yukon Street between W. 2nd and W. 12th avenues
- W. 12th Avenue between Cambie and Yukon streets
- W. Broadway

Hours of Work

Set up on site will begin around 5 a.m. on March 25, with the first concrete trucks arriving at 6 a.m. The concrete pour is scheduled until 10 p.m. with low noise work continuing overnight to finish related activities.

What to expect

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Cambie and Alberta streets.
- Residents and businesses in the area should expect elevated noise.
- Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms in place of white noise signals for crew safety.
- There will be overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Access to residences, businesses, and parkades will be maintained during all work activities.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, directing lights away from residential buildings and managing work activities to utilize less noisy equipment and methodologies in the evening and overnight.

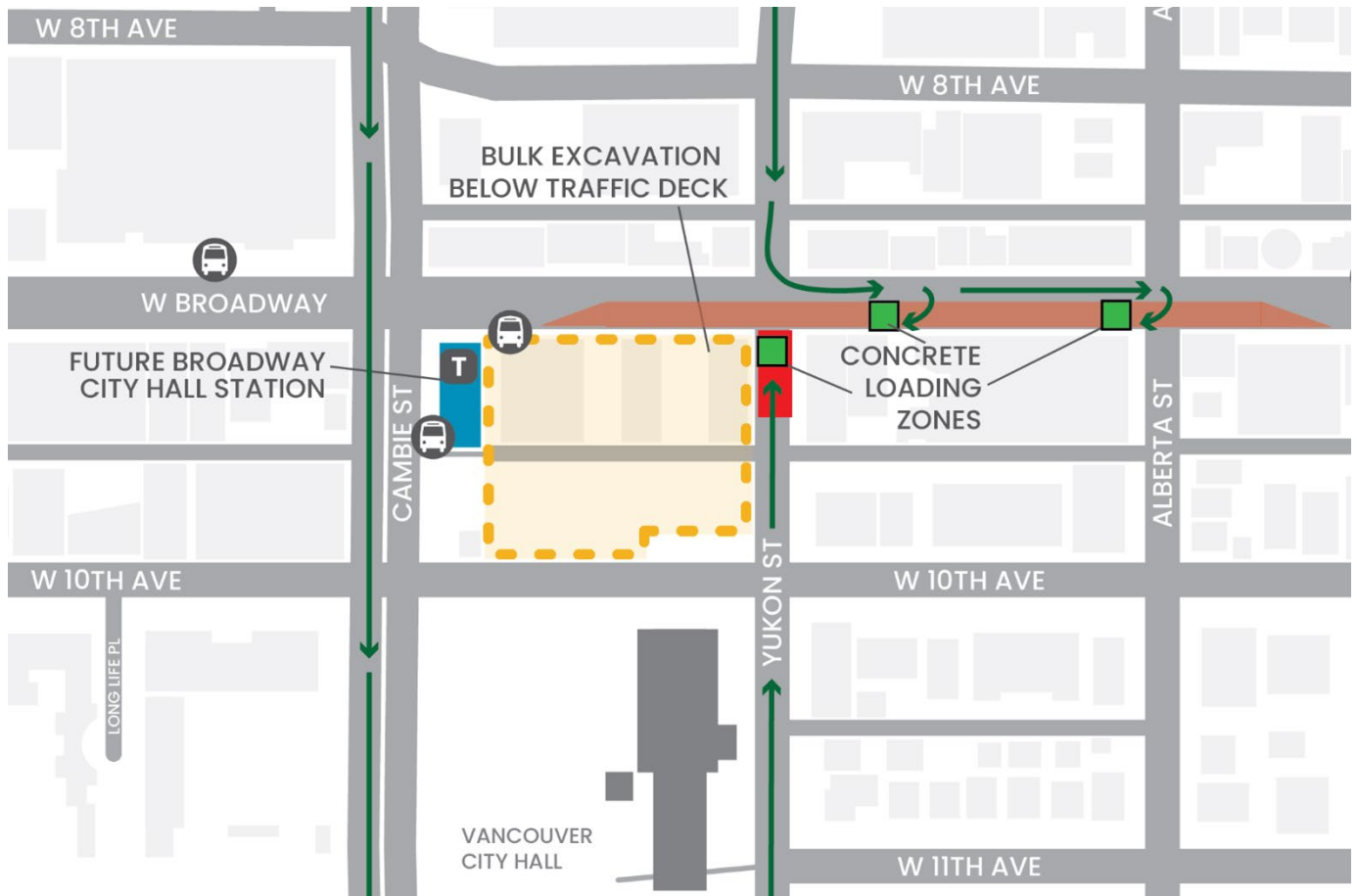
