





# Increased truck volumes around the Mount Pleasant site on March 28

## March 27, 2023

Note: The notice from December 19, 2022 includes this work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Mount Pleasant Station. Work on March 28 involves the pouring of the concrete foundation for the station entrance building (headhouse). This is the final major concrete pour for the base slab foundation at the future Mount Pleasant Station. In total, about 150-170 trucks will pour 1,500 cubic metres of concrete over the course of the day. Trucks will use the following streets:

- Main Street between E. 2<sup>nd</sup> and southward
- E. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Main and Quebec streets
- Quebec Street between E. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue and E. Broadway
- Laneway from Quebec St. to E. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue

#### **Hours of Work**

Set up on site will begin around 5 a.m. on March 28, with the first concrete trucks arriving at 6 a.m. The concrete pour is scheduled until 10 p.m. with low noise work continuing overnight to finish related activities.

## What to expect

- Elevated noise.
- Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms in place of white noise signals for crew safety.
- Main Street will be reduced to one lane southbound between Kingsway and E. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Trucks will stage on Main Street southbound between E. Broadway and E. 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, directing lights away from residential buildings and managing work activities to utilize less noisy equipment and methodologies in the evening and overnight. Access to residences, businesses, and parkades will be maintained during all work activities.




