





UPDATE: Work to install the traffic deck panels on the north side of W. Broadway at the future Arbutus Station continues through April

March 29, 2023

Note: The notices from February 13 and February 28 includes this work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood installing the <u>traffic deck</u> in the future Arbutus station blocks. While most of the work will be conducted during the day, there may be periods of night work. Work includes placing support beams, stabilizing pins, and installing traffic deck panels on the north side of W. Broadway, between Arbutus and Cypress streets. Additionally, crews will be intermittently working with hydro vac machines during daytime on Maple and Cypress streets north of W. Broadway as they complete work to support utilities in the area. The traffic deck is expected to be completed later this spring. The completed traffic deck will have four lanes of traffic, allowing work on the station to continue below while vehicles move above.

Timing

- Regular hours of work are Monday to Sunday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- This work is expected to take place intermittently until the end of April.

What to expect

- Elevated noise, particularly when hydro vac work is happening.
- Increased truck traffic, some traffic congestion, reduced speeds, and detours around the work as required.
- Sidewalk modifications, lane and turn restrictions on W. Broadway, Maple and Cypress streets.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and early evening and utilizing quieter types of equipment, when possible. There will be noise dampening panels around the hydro vac machines to help reduce noise. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
