





## Update: Night work at the future Oak-VGH Station continues until late May

March 31, 2023

Note: The notice from February 3, 2023 included this work and we now have current scheduling details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. As crews prepare the station for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines, we will continue working at night between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. excavating under the traffic deck between Laurel and Oak streets until late May.

## What to Expect

Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained throughout the night work. People in the area can expect some elevated noise during the work, and overnight lighting in the area focused on the site to maintain safety for our crews. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day, utilizing quieter models of equipment, including hand tools, and directing all lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
