

Noisy work on W. Broadway at Laurel Street on April 20

April 19, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH station. Crews will be using a hydro vac truck on the northwest corner of W. Broadway at Laurel Street to repair a utility pole.

Timing

- This work will take place on April 20 between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.

What to expect

- Elevated noise levels related to the hydro vac work.
- Increased truck traffic, some traffic congestion, and reduced speeds.
- Pedestrian detour with flaggers on the north side of W. Broadway at Oak and Laurel streets to help direct pedestrians.

Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
