

Next phase of construction begins at Arbutus Station

June 5, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) has completed the installation of the final traffic deck panel located in the two blocks of the future Arbutus Station. Excavation will continue throughout the summer with intermittent rock breaking. In parallel, a crane will be assembled, and crews will begin waterproofing, installing rebar, and pouring concrete. Efforts will be focused on constructing the underground station foundation and preparing for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines. Construction of the station will continue into 2024.

Work hours

Typical hours of work are Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. Crew arrival and set up can begin at 6 a.m. There may be occasional evening work, or work on Sundays and holidays between 9 a.m. and 8 p.m. We will continue to keep you informed of work in advance to help you plan accordingly.

What to expect

- Elevated noise
- Increased trucking volumes and temporary traffic changes related to the delivery of materials or specific construction work
- Crane activity
- Overnight Lighting



Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, installing noise barriers around sources of noise, conducting the noisiest activities during the day, directing lights away from residential buildings, and monitoring activities to adapt mitigations as needed to minimize impacts on our neighbours. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

- This phase will continue until Winter 2023.



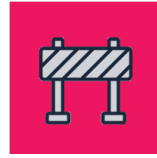
Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday: 7 a.m. - 10 p.m.
- There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays: 9 a.m. - 8 p.m.
- There may be occasional night work.
- Please note the Project also has the ability to work 24/7.



Traffic

- Reinstatement of right turns from W. Broadway onto Arbutus and Cypress streets.
- Reinstatement of dedicated left-turn lanes on W. Broadway onto Arbutus Street in both directions.
- Temporary traffic restrictions, sidewalk modifications, pedestrian detours, and lower speed limits.
- Temporary lane closures on W. Broadway may be implemented weekdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. or on weekends.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, rock breaking, crane movement, deliveries, rebar installation, and concrete activities.
- Increased trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day or night.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
