





Update: Night work at the future Oak-VGH Station continues

June 5, 2023

Note: The notice from March 31, 2023 includes this work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. As crews prepare the station for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines, we will continue working at night between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. between Laurel and Oak streets.

Timing

Night work hours are from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Work is planned through August.

What to expect

- Elevated noise related to deliveries, rebar installation, and crane movement of materials into the station area.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Increased trucking activities, temporary lane closures and changes to pedestrian access to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials to site and into the excavation.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day, utilizing quieter models of equipment, including hand tools, and directing all lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
