





Next phase of construction continues at the Elevated Guideway

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Elevated Guideway that connects VCC-Clark Station to the Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station. Completion of the Elevated Guideway's 21 upper pier caps and precast deck panels is imminent, and the next phase of construction to build the guideway decking will start in July 2023. The Elevated Guideway is expected to be completed by the end of 2023.


Work Hours

- Regular hours of work are Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. There may be occasional weekend work.
- Girder installation will involve some night work from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise
- Some night work, including overnight lighting directed at the site
- Increased construction vehicles and crane activity
- Possible temporary road closures, reduced speed limits, and travel lanes

What to Expect



Timing

- Construction to build the elevated guideway decking starts in July.
- The elevated guideway is expected to be complete by the end of 2023.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday with occasional weekend work: 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Some overnight work.



Traffic

- Closures:
 - Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
 - Foley Street north of parking access lane.
 - Fraser Street north side closed to E. 1st Avenue and Earl Finning Way.
- No parking:
 - Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.
 - Along Earl Finning Way, Foley, and Fraser streets.
 - Drivers are encouraged to use existing parkades.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Intermittent elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, construction of the elevated guideway decking, installation of girders and deliveries.
- People travelling or living in the area may notice an increase in construction vehicles and equipment.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
