

Increased truck volumes around the Oak-VGH site during concrete pours

Note: The notice from March 1, 2023 includes this work and we have updated details to share.

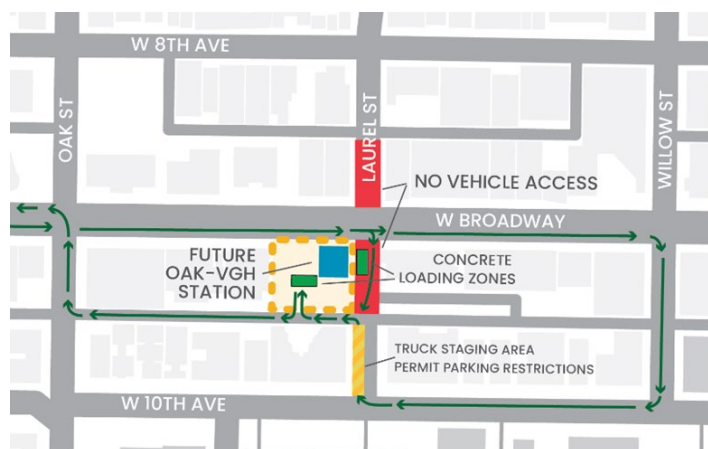
The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. Work on July 18 involves the first major concrete pour for the station foundation. Approximately 110 trucks will pour more than 1,000 cubic meters of concrete during the day, with additional pours over the coming months.

Timing

For each major pour, set up on site will begin around 5:00 a.m., with the first concrete trucks arriving at 6 a.m. The concrete pour is scheduled until 10 p.m. with low noise work continuing overnight to finish related activities.

What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to trucking. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Increased trucking activities. Traffic control personnel will be stationed at the alley south of W. Broadway between Oak and Laurel streets to help manage truck traffic.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Parking restrictions on Laurel Street. Access to residences, businesses, and parkades will be maintained during all work activities.
