

TBM Update: Phyllis continuing towards Oak-VGH Station

July 28, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building SkyTrain tunnels under Broadway. Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) Phyllis will continue her journey from Broadway-City Hall Station towards the future Oak-VGH Station soon. TBM Elsie is expected to follow Phyllis about four weeks later.

Timing

- Tunneling activities take place 24/7.
- Both TBMs are expected to complete their journeys at Cypress Street by the end of 2023.
- Hours of work may vary for other activities at the six station sites. For details visit [our Current Work page](#).

What to expect

- Intermittent vibration and some noise may be noticeable at the surface, similar to when large equipment is operating in the area.
- Vibration and noise from tunneling will be temporary as the TBMs move under Broadway.
- Short-term elevated noise when the TBM arrives at the Oak-VGH station area.

To prepare for tunneling, crews performed extensive geotechnical work to understand the ground conditions. In addition, ground conditions are monitored with real-time data during tunneling activities.
