

Night work to construct the future Oak-VGH Station continues through summer

August 15, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. Crews are currently completing the foundation and preparing for the arrival of the two tunnel boring machines this summer and early fall. Nighttime activities include work above and below the traffic deck delivering, handling, and installing rebar for the concrete foundation.

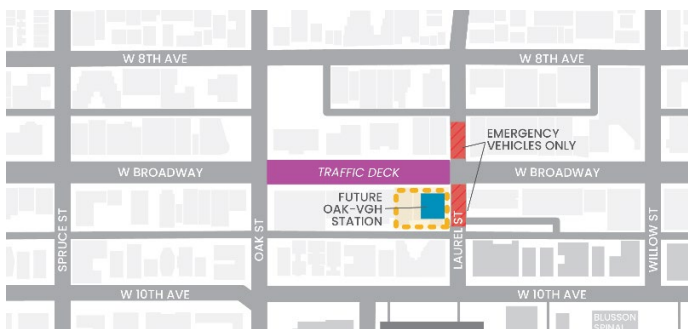
Timing

Night work hours are from 10 p.m. to 1:30 a.m. This work is planned until the end of September 2023.

What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to rebar installation and crane movement of materials into the excavation area.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Increased trucking activities, temporary lane closures, and changes to pedestrian access to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials to site and into the excavation.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and early evening, managing site activities to reduce the need for trucks to back up, installing white noise signals on construction equipment, utilizing quieter types of equipment and methodologies, monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings.
