





Overnight work at the future Oak-VGH Station August 9-15

August 9, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. As crews prepare the station for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines, we will be delivering materials and equipment to and from the station excavation on W. Broadway between Oak and Laurel Streets.

Timing

This work will take place between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. from August 9 to 15.

What to expect

- Elevated noise related to crane activity.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Temporary lane closures on W. Broadway between Oak and Laurel streets.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and directing all lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
