





Station construction underway at future Mount Pleasant Station

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Mount Pleasant Station. Throughout the remainder of 2023, work is focused on constructing the underground station. This includes regular concrete pours for the walls, columns and floors within the underground structure.

Work Hours

- Regular hours of station construction work are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays.
- Occasional overnight work from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.


What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise.
- Continued trucking activities. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Some night work, including overnight lighting directed at the site.
- Crane activity.

Timing

 Station construction continuing through 2024.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday with occasional work on Sundays and holidays: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Occasional night work: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

- No street parking on Broadway west of Kingsway. For more information on parking, check our <u>parking and</u> access maps page.
- Occassional closures of curb lanes for staging and deliveries:
 - Main Street southbound curb lane south of E.
 Broadway;
 - E. 10th Avenue westbound curb lane between Quebec Street and laneway; and
 - Quebec Street between laneway and E. 10th Avenue.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Intermittent elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, crane movement, deliveries, rebar installation, and concrete activities.
- Continued increased trucking activities. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required.
