





Tree and hedge removal on Arbutus Street north of W. Broadway

August 9, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Arbutus Station. Crews will be removing one maple tree and one cedar tree along with adjacent hedges on the west side of Arbutus Street between W. Broadway and W. 8th Avenue to safely accommodate underground utility line installation. The work zone is identified in orange in the map below.

The Project team will work with the City of Vancouver through the street design process to replace trees lost with new trees that will complement the existing trees in this neighbourhood. In addition, the landscape team will create vegetation features around the station areas to maintain the neighbourhood's distinct look and feel.

Timing

Hedge removal is expected to take place on Thursday, August 10 and Friday, August 11 between 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tree removal will be scheduled later this month.

What to expect

- Arbutus Street between W. Broadway and W. 8th Avenue will be closed to southbound traffic during the work.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained. Traffic control personnel will assist pedestrians as required.
- Vehicle access to the Shell Gas station from Arbutus Street will be maintained in the southern entrance while the northern entrance will be closed.
