





# Night work: Crews will shift traffic lanes on Cambie Street on November 24

### November 23, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Millennium Line extension. Overnight on November 24, Cambie Street from W. 8th Avenue south towards W. 12th Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction while crews shift the traffic lanes west to accommodate upcoming work on the underground passenger connections between the Canada Line and future Millennium Line platforms. Overnight work will include line eradication, line painting, relocating trolley lines and repositioning traffic signals. Once overnight work is complete, the traffic will return to two lanes in each direction.

#### **Timing**

November 24 starting at 8 p.m. and continuing until 5 a.m. the following morning.

#### What to expect

- Cambie street will temporarily be reduced to one lane in each direction between W. 8th and W. 12th avenues.
- Some elevated noise.
- Overnight lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.
- Pedestrians may be detoured around work zones.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, directing lights away from residents, and monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
