

Night work at the future Arbutus Station continues through Spring

November 22, 2023

Note: The notice from September 11, 2023 includes this work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Arbutus Station. As crews prepare the station for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines and the next phase of construction, we will continue working overnight along W. Broadway between Arbutus and Cypress streets. Night work includes, but is not limited to, welding, rebar installation, waterproofing, crane activities, and road repairs as required. Additional daytime work includes trucking, installing other materials, and pouring concrete.

Timing

Typical hours of work are from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Intermittent overnight work hours are from 10 p.m. until 4 a.m. and will continue through the Spring.

What to expect

- Some elevated noise.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing noise barriers when required, utilizing quieter models of equipment at night, including hand tools, and directing all lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
