

Overnight road repairs on W. Broadway and Cambie Street November 16

November 15, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Millennium Line extension.

Overnight on November 16, crews will repair potholes at multiple locations on W. Broadway and Cambie Street near the future Broadway-City Hall Station. While there will continue to be temporary changes to accommodate construction activities, the current traffic configuration along Broadway will remain in place until the traffic decks are removed later in the project.

Timing

The road repair work will take place overnight on November 16 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.

What to expect

- Overnight work.
- Intermittent elevated noise related to pothole patching.
- Overnight lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.
- Temporary rolling traffic changes will be implemented at multiple locations on W. Broadway and Cambie Street during this work.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, monitoring any noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings.
