





Station construction underway at Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station site

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Great Northern Way–Emily Carr Station. Over the summer of 2023, various activities will be taking place, including the construction of the station entrance building section, starting with excavation and shoring work. This will be followed by the pouring of the concrete foundation, walls and columns, and then the concourse level. Simultaneously, removal of tunnel soil from tunnel boring activities continues via the conveyor system through 2023. The Great Northern Way–Emily Carr Station is expected to be completed in 2024.


Work Hours

- Tunnelling work, including transport of soil from excavation via the conveyor system, is 24 hours 7 days a week.
- Regular hours of station work are Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. with occasional weekend work
- Rebar installation will involve some night work from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise
- Some night work, including overnight lighting directed at the site
- Crane activity
- Continued trucking volumes and temporary traffic changes

What to Expect



Timing

 Station construction continuing until 2024.



Hours of Work

- Work on the station continues
 Monday to Friday, 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.,
 with occasional weekend work.
- Tunnelling work is 24/7.
- Occasional night work, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

- Temporary trucking route along E.
 1st Avenue to be maintained until end of August, 2023.
- Road closures:
 - Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
 - Foley Street north of parking access lane.
 - Fraser Street north of Great Northern Way is closed at E. 1st Avenue and Earl Finning Way.
- No parking:
 - Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.
 - Drivers are encouraged to use existing parkades.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Intermittent elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, excavation, crane movement, deliveries, rebar installation, and concrete activities.
- Accumulated dust, mud, and gravel are managed by street sweepers.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
