

## Major concrete pours move to the east side of the future Arbutus Station

December 13, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Arbutus Station. Previous concrete pours have taken place between Arbutus and Maple streets. On December 16, crews will complete the first major concrete pour for the station's foundation between Maple and Cypress streets. Approximately 65 trucks will pour more than 650 cubic meters of concrete during the day.

Over the coming months, a series of major concrete pours of varying volumes will occur to complete the station's concrete foundation between Maple and Cypress streets.

### Timing

On December 16, setup will start around 7 a.m. and the pour will continue until 8 p.m.

For the subsequent major pours, setup will begin as early as 5 a.m. The first concrete trucks will arrive on site at approximately 6 a.m. and continue until 10 p.m.

### What to expect

- For the December 16<sup>th</sup> concrete pour:
  - Concrete trucks will travel to Cypress Street via W. Broadway. Once concrete is poured, trucks will exit Cypress via W. 8th Avenue eastbound.
  - Cypress Street north of W. Broadway will be closed to public vehicle access.
  - The pedestrian crossing at W. Broadway and Cypress Street on the north side will be re-routed to 8th Avenue.
- Some elevated noise related to trucking. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Concrete trucks may stage on the westbound curb lane of W. Broadway between Fir and Pine streets. Further truck staging may occur on W. Broadway at the northeast corner of Cypress Street and on W. Broadway at Maple Street.
- W. Broadway may be reduced to one lane in each direction during the work.
- Traffic control personnel to help manage traffic during all work.
- Night lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Access to residences, businesses, and parkades will be maintained during all work activities.
- Low noise work continuing overnight to finish related activities.
