





UPDATE: Overnight work to build the future Oak-VGH Station continues into the Spring 2024

December 12, 2023

Note: This is an update of the notification from September 28, 2023, and we now have an updated schedule.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. Nighttime activities include, but are not limited to, material and equipment delivery, crane movement and rebar installation to build the future station.

Timing


Night work hours are from 10 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. This work is planned through Spring 2024.

What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to rebar installation and crane movement of materials into the excavation area.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Increased trucking activities, temporary lane closures, and changes to pedestrian access to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials to site and into the excavation.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and early evening, managing site activities to reduce the need for trucks to back up, installing white noise signals on construction equipment where possible, utilizing quieter types of equipment and methodologies, monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings.
