





Broadway remains open during material delivery to station areas

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Millennium line extension. We're committed to keeping people moving during construction. We are maintaining four lanes of traffic in station areas on Broadway during weekday peak periods, with lane closures planned primarily in off peak times. For Arbutus Station, you may experience intermittent lane closures during the morning rush hour. Between station areas, six lanes of traffic are open during rush hour, with on-street parking in some locations in off-peak times.

Off peak times include:

- 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. weekdays
- Weekends

Station areas include:

- Mount Pleasant: Main to Quebec streets
- Broadway-City Hall: Alberta to Cambie streets
- Oak-VGH: Laurel to Oak streets
- South Granville: Hemlock to Granville streets
- Arbutus: Cypress to Arbutus streets

What to expect

- Temporary lane closures for deliveries, crane movement of materials into the station areas and work on the traffic deck.
- Traffic control personnel will be present, as required, to assist with the safe movement of traffic, cyclists, and pedestrians.

Access to businesses, residences, parking lots and health services will be maintained. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
