



Next phase of construction begins at South Granville station

April 24, 2023

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is nearing the completion of the excavation phase of construction in the future South Granville Station. Excavation will continue throughout spring. In May, crews will begin waterproofing, installation of rebar, and pouring of concrete as efforts become focused on constructing the underground station foundation and preparing for the arrival of the tunnel boring machines in the fall. There may be intermittent rock-breaking while excavation continues. Some activities may be conducted at night. Construction of the station will continue into 2024. Work hours

Typical hours of work are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays between 9 a.m. and 8 p.m. To stay informed about work in your neighbourhood check the website.

What to expect

- Elevated noise
- Increased trucking activity
- Temporary traffic changes
- Crane activity

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on some equipment, installing noise barriers around sources of noise, conducting the noisiest activities during the day, directing lights away from residential buildings, utilizing quieter equipment where possible, and monitoring activities to adapt mitigations as needed to minimize impacts on our neighbours.

Timing

• This phase will continue through winter 2023/24



Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday: 6 a.m. 10 p.m.
- There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays: 9 a.m. 8 p.m.
- There may be occasional night work.
- Please note the Project also has the ability to work 24/7.



Traffic

- Lower speed limits and temporary lane closures on W. Broadway weekdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. or on weekends. Work is scheduled in off-peak periods to keep people moving.
- Additional restrictions for deliveries of concrete, equipment and materials including pedestrian detours.
- Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, rock breaking, crane movement, deliveries, rebar installation, and concrete activities.
- Increased trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day or night
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
