

## Night work for piezometer, geotechnical, and CCTV inspections between future station locations continues in 2024

January 25, 2024

Before and after the tunnel boring machines pass, the Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) continues to monitor ground and water conditions as well as utilities across the alignment of the future Millennium Line extension. The various geotechnical, piezometer and closed-circuit TV (CCTV) readings will be taken overnight throughout 2024.

### Timing

To minimize traffic disruptions, the work will be performed overnight throughout 2024 between station sites from the Great Northern Way-Emily Carr to Arbutus station locations.

### What to expect

- Temporary single-lane closures of up to one hour for CCTV monitoring locations with reduced speeds and detours around the work as required.
- For geotechnical monitoring device and piezometer readings, there will be short-term traffic lane shifts (about 15-minutes in duration) at the test locations.
- A traffic truck with direction lights will indicate the lane shift, while crews take the geotechnical or piezometer readings.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, working at night to minimize traffic disruptions and use of handheld electric drills to minimize drilling noise. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
