





# Night work to maintain traffic deck at Broadway-City Hall in February

### February 2, 2024

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Broadway-City Hall Station. Beginning February 5, crews will conduct scheduled maintenance of the traffic deck along W. Broadway between Cambie and Alberta streets and within the excavation. Work activities may require temporary lane closures. The current traffic configuration along Broadway will remain in place outside of temporary lane closures until the traffic decks are removed later in the project.

### **Timing**

- Starting on February 5 for one month.
- Night work hours from 8 p.m. each night and continuing until 5 a.m. the following morning.

#### What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to welding activities.
- Intermittent temporary lane closures overnight or in off-peak hours, changes to street parking and speed limits.
- Lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, directing lights away from residential buildings, managing trucking routes to reduce the need for backing up, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, and monitoring noisy activities so that measures can be adapted as needed. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
