

## Construction at Broadway-City Hall focuses on station structure

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Broadway-City Hall Station. Construction of the station will continue through 2024 and is currently focused on installing waterproofing membrane, rebar, formwork and concrete to construct station walls, columns and floors. In addition, crews are working along Cambie Street from W. Broadway to W. 10th Avenue constructing the future passenger connections between the Millennium Line extension and the existing Canada Line Station.

### Timing

- Typical hours of work are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m.
- Regular night work takes place Sunday to Friday from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays between the hours of 9 a.m. and 8 p.m.
- Activities related to tunneling continue 24/7 through spring 2024.

### What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to specific construction activities.
- Night work to excavate and construct the tunnelled passenger connections between the Millennium Line extension and the existing Canada Line Station.
- Lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.
- Trucking activity to accommodate delivery of equipment and materials, including concrete.
- Intermittent temporary traffic lane restrictions during off-peak hours, changes to street parking, speed limits.
- Intermittent night work to relocate equipment using mobile cranes.
- There may be intermittent nighttime deliveries of equipment and material.
- Pedestrians may be detoured around work zones.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest work during the day and shoulder hours, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Thank you for your continued patience while we build this important transportation infrastructure project.
