





Construction continues at the future Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station day and night work through 2024

February 21, 2024

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station. Construction of the station will continue through this year and is currently focused on the following activities that relate to the construction of the station entrance building including shoring, waterproofing, rebar, formwork removal and concrete works. Simultaneously, the removal of tunnel soil from tunnel boring activities will continue via the conveyor system until boring is completed in spring 2024. Station construction at Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station will continue through 2024.


Timing

- Tunnelling work, including conveyor system and soil excavation, will be performed 24 hours 7 days a week.
- Regular hours of station work are Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. with occasional weekend work.
- Nightwork will be intermittent from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise.
- Overnight lighting.
- Crane activity.
- Temporary traffic changes as required.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest work during the day and shoulder hours, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, use hand-tools when applicable, monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Hours of Work

- Work on the station continues Monday to Friday, 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., with occasional weekend work.
- Tunnelling work: 24/7.
- Intermittent night work: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Traffic

- Closures:
 - Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
 - Foley Street north of parking access lane.
 - Fraser Street north of Great Northern Way is closed at E. 1st Avenue and Earl Finning Way.
- No parking:
 - Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Intermittent elevated noise.
- Cleanliness of the trucking route is managed by street sweepers.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
