



Night work at Great Northern Way–Emily Carr Station from Feb 14-28

February 14, 2024

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Great Northern Way–Emily Carr Station between Thornton and Carolina streets. Intermittent night work is planned through 2024, beginning with removal of formwork over the next two weeks. Further notification will be provided prior to future night work.

Timing

- Overnight work intermittently from February 14 to 28.

What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to formwork disassembly and removal.
- Lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.
- There will be intermittent crane activity.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, managing the site plan to reduce the need for backing up, using handheld radios for worker communication, using white-noise backup signals on equipment, installing noise barriers, monitoring noise levels, and using quieter versions of equipment when applicable.
