



Utility work near South Granville Station on March 4,5,11, & 12

February 29, 2024

Note: The notice from January 10, 2024 includes this work and we have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future South Granville Station. On March 4 and 5 and then again on March 11 and 12, we will be working in the laneways south of W. Broadway to W. 10th Avenue and between Granville and Hemlock streets to confirm the location of utilities.

Timing

- March 4 to 5 (highlighted in orange on map) and March 11 to March 12 (highlighted in red on map).
- Work hours are 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

What to expect

- Elevated noise related to construction activities including hydro vac work, road repairs, and utility work.
- Access to parkades, businesses, and services will be maintained.
- Temporary lane closures to accommodate deliveries and trucking activity.

March 4 and 5:

- Single-lane alternating traffic on 10th Avenue between Granville Street and the laneway.
- The north sidewalk on 10th Avenue will be closed at the laneway, flaggers will help pedestrians cross as required (see green dashed line on map).
- Vehicles can access businesses from Hemlock Street along the east-west alley. There will be detour signs and a flagger at the entrance to the alley on 10th Avenue to detour drivers to Hemlock Street.

March 11 and 12:

- Access to the east-west laneway via Hemlock Street will be closed.
- Access to the laneway via 10th Avenue will be maintained.
- The southbound curb lane on Hemlock Street south of W. Broadway will be closed between 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- The west sidewalk on Hemlock Street will be closed and pedestrians will be detoured to the east sidewalk (see green dashed line on map).
- Vehicles can access businesses via 10th Avenue along the north-south alley. There will be detour signs
 and a flagger at the entrance to the alley on Hemlock Street to detour drivers to 10th Avenue.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and installing sound dampening panels next to hydro vac work locations. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.


